How to Enter:

Tournament Playing Conditions

1. Players are deemed to have accepted the conditions on the entry form when they request entry into the event, regardless of when the entry fee is paid.
2. The format for the event is games of 100-up, with the baulk-line crossing rule in play (80 to 99 Points). As many matches will not have qualified referees, the onus is on the player even if he has not received a warning.
3. The event will commence with a round robin draw, the top 2 players from each group (at a minimum) will qualify for the knockout stage. The length of round robin matches will depend on entry numbers and available tables. Knock-out matches will be best of 5 up to and including the quarter-finals, best of 7 for the semi-finals, and best of 9 for the final.
4. A consolation plate event will only be run if entry numbers permit and a suitable time is available.
5. The event dress code is long sleeve shirts buttoned at the wrist, dark coloured dress trousers and dark colour dress shoes. Waistcoats and a tie or bow tie are required for the knock-out stages. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the game. The tournament director may vary this dress code in extreme circumstances.
6. All players will be scheduled to referee one or more round robin matches, and this will be shown on the playing schedule. Players will also be required to referee knock-out matches up to the quarter-final stage.
7. All players are to be ready to play at least 10 minutes before the scheduled start of their match and should report to the tournament director on arrival at the venue. A game will be awarded against players not present at the start of the match, and one further game each 15 minutes until the match is decided.
8. Seeding into knock-out stage from the round robin will be calculated based on the standard WBL method.
9. Please note: Singapore has a withholding tax; bank account details will be required for the transfer of prize monies, which can take approximately three weeks.
10. This Entry Form constitutes part of the Conditions of Entry.
11. The Tournament Director has absolute discretion to vary these conditions when circumstances dictate and to make decisions on any matter not covered by these conditions.
